A commemoration of the 200th anniversary of the settling of Bodega Bay by the Russian-America Company. The beginning of the celebration, on April 4th, 2012, will feature the LADY WASHINGTON, representing the CHIRIKOV flying the RAC flag, which will arrive in Bodega Bay, escorted by historic baidarkas and Russian longboats to open the celebrations. Accompanying events will include banquets, exhibits, lectures, and dance and music ensembles from the Russian Centre in San Francisco. Special guests from Tot'ma (Bodega Bay's Sister-City) and Moscow will be an important part of the celebrations,

and lectures by specialists on Russian-America's history will be presented to the public.

Jenner - Special celebrations will continue throughout the month: on April 21, a special regatta involving historic baidarkas and Russian longboats, as well as modern kayaks will ascend the Russian River as part of the Russian River's commemoration of the 200th anniversary.
